A forensic interview is a single session, recorded interview designed to gently obtain information from a child about an allegation of abuse. The goal of the CAC is to be the first step in healing hearts and offering hope to victims and their family. We work in a collaborative effort with the District Attorney's Office, Law Enforcement, and the Department of Human Resources (DHR) to coordinate services for the victim and their family while the investigation is ongoing. Our office is located in Dallas County with a satellite office in Bibb County so that we are able to offer services at both locations for victims in Bibb, Dallas, Hale, Perry or Wilcox counties.
