

STATE OF ALABAMA GROWERS PERMIT





Under the Code of Alabama, 1975, Title 2, Section 2-29-10, titled **Regulation By Municipalities of sale, etc., of farm products by farmers or other producers thereof**, which states as follows: It shall be unlawful for any municipality to charge the farmer or others engaged in the production of farm products of whatever nature any license fee for the sale or other disposition of such farm products produced by them at any place, nor shall such municipality prevent the sale of such products by the producer thereof when the said farmer shall have complied with all reasonable regulations for the sale of such products in such municipality.

Under the Code of Alabama, 1975, Title 40, Section 40-23-4, titled **Exemptions**, ... exempted from the provisions of this division and from the computation of the amount of the tax levied, assessed, or payable under this division ... **Item (44)** the gross receipts derived from the sale or sales of fruit or other agricultural products by the person or corporation that planted, cultivated, and harvested such fruit or agricultural product.

The Calhoun County Commission has provided a Farmers Market for the people of Calhoun County to sell the products that they grow or manufacture on their farm or in their home or on rented land.

The County Commission, for your convenience, has decided that there will be no fees charged for using the Farmers Market, but since space is limited, it will be occupied on "first come-first served" basis for a 12 hour period only. At the beginning of a new day, it goes back to "first come-first served."
